The Grumpy Collier Railtour

Day One Sunday 10th September

Arrival day in Brno when all participants met in the evening to discuss the forthcoming trip & introduce themselves to the rest of the group. Due to everyone making their own way to Brno, nothing was planned to happen as a group until the next morning. We were staying at the Grande Hotel, a large, well-appointed building opposite the main railway station, on a major tram junction. Heaven!

Day Two Monday 11th September

We had a substantial breakfast this morning & then assembled outside with our cases, ready for the short trip to the train. The day did not start well when the coach sent to collect us arrived & was found to be too small, the solution being that we were shuttled to Brno Dolni depot, where the tour train awaited us, in 2 groups. This resulted in some of us having insufficient time to view the contents of the depot, which is a preservation site, as we did not want to lose our path on the main line.

Once we were safely on board our train, which consisted of 2 vintage coaches (1 of them with bar and kitchen facilities) hauled by "Grumpy" 749 254, we set off for Ceska Trebova 39 mins. late.

At Ceska Trebova the train reversed into the CD depot from the station & we alighted for a full visit. It was very hot & after more than 90 mins walking round the scrap dumps & buildings most of us were flagging a little. We all got back on the train (many of us taking advantage of the refreshment facilities) which proceeded past the station to the CZ Loko & EZ depots. Once we had taken photos here, we boarded the train and set off again. We were served a bowl of goulash with bread for our lunch whilst travelling to the next destination, this combined with some liquid refreshment was appreciated by everyone.

The train reversed at Usti nad Orlici & headed to Letohrad where we reversed into the CZ Loko depot which is used to service mostly track machines but there were a couple of diesels & a dismantled steam loco. We were then treated to an additional stop, in the form of a visit to a preservation site at Dolni Lipka, where 3 diesels & 2-10-0 steam loco 555.0153 were in residence.

We set off for our final visit of the day, Olomouc Depot, which was reached with the train again reversing in from the station. After a long, hot visit the train took us back to Olomouc hln. Here we walked across the road and checked into the Clarion Congress Hotel.

Day Three Tuesday 12th September

The day dawned with another forecast of hot weather. A good breakfast was taken before most of us boarded a coach, this time one of the correct size, which took us to the main tram depot in Olomouc, where a visit had been arranged. Some thought the visit was rather long but, as we had a guide it would have appeared a little rude to just rush around without asking some questions about the system and how they operate it. Anyway, we reboarded the coach and returned to the station.

It appears that we saw all but 4 of the tram fleet, with those who went out before breakfast seeing 2 more working. The final 2 were locked inside the two-road shed next to the tram run-round loop adjacent to the railway station.

We boarded the train for the first time that day and headed towards Bohumin, on the way passing through Ostrava Svinov where chaos ensued, with numbers being shouted out from all directions as we passed numerous yards full of notable items. Just before we reached the main station at Bohumin we pulled off the main line into Bohumin Vrbicka yard. Here there were 6 locos & after some hurried

discussions with our hosts the haulage fanatics persuaded them to start up 2 of the class 703 shunters for a short ride up the siding & back in the cabs. A real bonus for those who wanted it.

We carried on to Bohumin where the train was reversed into the depot for another long walk in blist-eringly hot conditions. Whilst walking around the depot we were told that CD "Taurus" 1216.951 is there as a "Christmas tree" to provide spares for other members of the class. Disappointing for the haulage bashers who need it. This was followed by a quick visit to the EMU depot where several withdrawn class 460 units were awaiting their fate.

Leaving Bohumin we headed east to Detmarovice where we visited the EDE Vlecka branch which gave us 8 hard to get freight locos, 7 class 740 & a single class 771. After getting back on board we had a late lunch of meatloaf with bread & pickles-very welcome. Travelling onwards we arrived at Louky and Olsi where we reversed direction to reach the PKP depot and mine complex at Darkov. Here we found 6 locos with 7 more about a mile further on at Stonavka.

All that was left for the day was the hour+ run to Ostrava hln. where we were picked up by a bus and taken the 2 kms. to the Ostrava Mercure, our hotel for the next 2 nights

Day 4 Wednesday 13th September

As usual the day was started with a hearty breakfast before being picked up by bus and delivered to Ostrava hln. We eventually boarded the train and left 25mins. late due to pathing issues. First destination today were the steel works at Vitkovice doprava via a freight line through Ostrava. As we passed the back of a public park I saw what I took to be a concrete stand for a single bicycle at the base of a large tree. However, as we moved on, the stand appeared to be moving up & down. It was then that those onboard realised that what we were looking at was a couple caught "in flagrante delicto". The appearance of a train less than 100yds away did not seem to dampen their ardour and they were still at it as we disappeared out of site. Great amusement was had by all.

We reached the steel works depot area and stepped out into the yard. A leisurely stroll around the depot and yard followed, some of us managed to get a cab ride up the yard as well. 20+ locos were observed here including some narrow gauge. From here we walked into the adjacent Skoda works where we saw EMU body shells for export being assembled, but the only loco on site was "Grumpy" 749.121. We were informed that this loco is "out of ticket" for main line duties but is being used to test electrical components on new Comfortjet stock being built on site.

Returning to the train we retraced our steps to Ostrava Stred where our loco ran round ready to run us the short distance to Ostrava Kuncice. We were 40mins. down by this time & had lost our booked path so we waited whilst 729.504 was given priority in front of us, then we proceeded to Ost. Kuncice Station. Here a coach was waiting to take us into the Liberty Steel complex. The first thing we were shown was plinthed steam loco 317.015, followed by 741.721 which was shunting nearby. Our guide was persuaded to allow us to climb on the loco for a short trip up the siding.

We returned to the coach for a 10min. run across the works to the loco depot. Here we found 10 more "hard to get" locos and we had the chance to ride on another-741.717. Once done here we returned to the coach, which took us back to Kuncice stn. & our train. On boarding the train we collected our lunch of sausages with bread & sauce and a drink, which we were all ready for, then had a long wait for a path for the short (2km) into Vratimov.

On arrival at Vratimov we were delayed a further 45mins. due to a mix up with the paperwork which put us 85mins. down when we set off to traverse part of the Staric branch. Our destination was a con-tainer terminal with a PKP depot at Dul Paskov servicing the locos that worked the traffic. A pair of PKP 740s were in the yard waiting to depart with 10 more locos in & around the depot. The big surprise here was a PKP "Vectron" (193 590), apparently at the depot as a guinea pig, to see if they can branch out into electric loco servicing with the downturn of the coal industry and its use of

diesels. The branch is not electrified, so if the idea is successful all electrics will be dragged to the depot.

We left Dul Paskov approx. 100mins. late due, again, to pathing issues but this meant that by the time we reached Ostrava depot, our final visit of the day, it may have cooled down a little.

On the way we passed through Kuncice where ZSSK 131.001/002 were seen in the yard, resplendent in their new green livery. We passed through Ostrava hln. & depot and pulled into a yard for the loco to run round again so that it could take us into the depot where it was being stabled overnight. Arrival in the depot was 126mins. late and the guide was in a hurry to get home, so we set off at a rapid pace. He showed us round one of the quarter roundhouses but was reluctant to allow us into the other one, however, after much pleading & begging by Pete Eizens he rang a colleague who brought a key to open the shed. Inside there were 8 locos so this brought the total seen on the depot to 78. A good haul for a working day and a nice finish to the day. The bus collected us from the depot and deposited us at the Ostrava Mercure, our second night in this hotel.

Day 5 Thursday 14th September 2023

After another substantial breakfast we left the Ostrava Mercure hotel for the last time and boarded the bus for the short journey to Ostrava hln., where we boarded our train and departed at 0825. Over-night we had torrential rain, and the hope was that this would break the very hot weather and make our journey a little more comfortable.

We noted 9 locos as we passed through Kuncice and 3 more during a brief stop at Paskov. The first visit today was to Go Steel, at Liskovek u Frydku. Here one of the works shunters was waiting (709.506), and this was attached to the rear of our train to push us onto their property. Everyone detrained and we were able to take photos inside the small engine shed where 709.514 and a MUV were residing. It must be said that the company representatives seemed very nervous by our visit, but everyone be-haved well, and we were all very grateful that the visit was allowed. The fact that they used their shunter to shunt us into & out of their property was the highlight of the visit for most of us.

Continuing forward we arrived at Frydek-Mistek where a visit to the shed found it full of cars & motorcycles with just 2 DMUs outside. Plinthed in the yard was the front (described in the book as the torso) of steam loco 534.0316. This consisted of the chimney, smoke box, smoke deflectors, buffer beam & front axle of this 1946 built 2-10-0 Skoda. The disappointing tally was soon forgotten when it was realised that one of our party had managed to tear a hole in his trousers. Despite it being the ever-popular editor of Today's Railways, he was "ragged" mercilessly (pun intended on two counts, I'll leave it to you to work them out), sympathy was not forthcoming. My favourite comment, made by someone who will remain nameless, (Pete Eizens), was that the obvious headline could only be "Paparazzo caught with his trousers down". The ladies in the train crew, who look after us so well on these tours, produced a sewing kit and repaired the damage whilst he sat in the crew area in his grots. I feel in this instance they went above & beyond their duties to save his blushes.

Carrying on south we arrived at Velasske Mezirici where the spacious depot awaited us. In and around the depot there were 6 locos plus 8 old units & 4 new units (sharks). A long walk down the yard followed where we found some damaged units and further on, we uncovered (almost literally) some class 460 EMU centre cars buried in the undergrowth. We boarded the train to cross over the main line and enter the preservation site on the other side of the main line. Here we had a leisurely visit seeing 4 diesels, steam loco 423.041 & some vintage coaching stock which included what appeared to be a double deck set of 4.

Back on the train it was time for lunch, and today it consisted of a large baguette filled with fried chicken pieces and some salad, which went down well with a beer. This was consumed as we made our way to Vsetin where a visit to the Arriva depot had been arranged. The station and surrounding

trackwork, including the depot approach lines, were in effect a building site, but the train got in and we all got off. One class 742 was shunting in the yard & there were 4 units in & around the depot. 3 more units were in the station area as we headed back from whence we came.

Retracing our path through Velasske Mezirici and then on towards Hranice nad Morave, we passed the large Cabot chemical plant at Lhotka nad Becvou where we managed to see 740.820 which was hidden by dense vegetation. On arrival at Hranice nad Morave we detrained and walked 400mtrs. to the CZMO Elektronika works. 4 units were inside having safety equipment upgrades. Outside was shunter 703.558 & "Bobina" 140.076 which was stored at the bottom of the yard. The final offering was 703.657 which was in the adjoining rail yard , and according to our guide, is used occasionally to shunt in the works.

That concluded our visits for the day so all that was left was the run to Prerov where our hotel for the night was situated. On the way we passed some engineering work at Drahotuse where 3 locos were busy, and on the approach to Prerov Hln. 2 very rusty locos were seen, one identified as 710.029, the other possibly 751.141.

We were stopping at the Jana Hotel which involved a coach journey from Prerov station as it is located about 25mins. walk away.

Day 6 Friday 15th September

Following a hearty breakfast, we were picked up by coach and dropped into the DPOV works at Prerov. The main contract here was to upgrade class 799 shunters, there being 6 of the class having work undertaken on them, plus works pilot 799.011 was also present. Other locos of note were a 121, 2x140's & 2x182's. Our train had stabled overnight in the works yard and was manoeuvred into position to pick us up. We then moved into the yard south of Prerov Hln. Present here were 4 locos, one each from classes 111,731,742 & 744. We were waiting to reverse into the CMZO works when 714.029 arrived dragging 799.035 and a rake of coaches. 2 new class 650/2 units also passed us, working services.

After quite a long wait we received permission to reverse into the works and we detrained. The haulage brigade quickly negotiated a ride on the works shunter, 704.706, for anyone that wanted to and then we were off for the tour of the premises. We walked around the outside of the buildings first where there was plenty of variety, including ex works locos, dismantled locos, stored locos, preserved locos & a few unit cars. Inside, the buildings were packed with locos in various stages of reconstruction as you would expect. At least 12 classes of loco were present in the works.

Once everyone was back on board the train backed out onto the main line, during which operation a triple headed coal train was seen passing. The locos were 2 class 741s and SDKD 184.503, the only 184 owned by SDKD that we missed on last year's visit to Tusimice.

We headed south, and, with a request having been made for the driver to try and pass Hulin at as slow a pace as he could, we prepared our cameras. As we passed the yard the cameras clicked with the result being that we had captured 11 locos, which included 4 ex DB 180'S. At Stare Mesto we branched off east, then at Uherskeho Hradiste we headed south, finally arriving at Veseli nad Moravou. Here we were shunted a couple of times to gain access to the busy DPOV depot/works. The site was full of units & trailers with a couple of locos present and after a leisurely walk around the site, under a very hot midday sun, we returned to the train to be served with a lunch of mixed salad with cheese, salami, and bread rolls, washed down with the drink of your choice. We were certainly ready for it.

Leaving the depot behind we headed west towards Brno, passing through Kyjov and Blazovice arriving at Brno-Slatina. We reversed a couple of times before backing into the LKTR depot where 11 varied diesels were parked. Photos taken we climbed back on board for what should have been an

early finish at Brno Hln. However, CD had other ideas and we were kept waiting 65mins. due to there being no platform available at the hln. Eventually we got the green light and we arrived at Brno to book into the Grande Hotel.

Day 7 Saturday 16th September

The last day with the train dawned and, following breakfast, we assembled in front of our hotel ready to be picked up by the coach. It duly arrived and deposited us at Dolni depot where the ever reliable 749.254 was waiting to whisk us away for another day of fun & frolics. After a short run through Brno, via Zidenice stn., we arrived at the large, spread-out depot of Malomerice. For those members who don't know, Brno Malomerice is the depot where Eva, our tour manager, works.

During our time around Brno we had noted the many new class 530/550 units working the local trains, so it came as no surprise to find 19 class 242's stored in and around the depot following their replacement by said EMU's. By the time we had finished walking around this large and spread-out depot we had noted more than 50 locos, plus units & trailers. We filed back onto the train and set off across Brno to the depot at Horni Herspice, where a mix of DMU's presented themselves, along with 3 locos plus 1 arriving with coaching stock from Brno hln.

Next on our agenda was a visit to the short branch serving TSR, a scrap metal dealer, at Modrice. Stored here were 5 shunters. Also stored here were 4 units and some rolling stock all in a dilapidated condition. Shunting the scrap yard was another, unidentified shunter, possibly 700.668. Once finished here we collected our lunch of hard-boiled egg & baked beans with bread which we consumed whilst heading for our next port of call, Breclav depot. We arrived just after 1200 with not a cloud in the sky.

The train stopped in the middle of the depot, and we were off, 40 Englishmen (mostly) out in the midday sun. No mad dogs, they must have thought it was too hot. It was a long walk, in stifling heat but the rewards were 60+ locos with a further 12 in and around the station area. 5 PKP Vectrons were parked in a line in the station/yard area, a nice bonus for many of us.

Back on the train we settled down for our 2+ hour run to Znojmo. We passed through the freight yard where the depot is located picking off 4 locos on the way, and arrived in the station, then reversed into the depot. There were 7 units and a loco here. We left 22 mins. down on the schedule. By the time we arrived at Miroslav we were 20 mins. down and Pete Eizens, who was leaving Brno as soon as we got back, was worried about making his connection to Vienna. This was compounded when we were told that we were being held for a late running local that was being put in front of us. Eva, aware of Pete's problem arranged for him to leave the train and catch the local, which was going direct to Brno hln., giving him a +12 connection & so saving the day. We bid farewell to Pete and eventually arrived back ourselves at Brno Dolni where we said our goodbyes to the train crew for another year. We caught the coach back to our hotel and that was the end of another very successful tour.

Mention was made in the numeric report of a loco seen on the last section of the tour after Miroslav. Nick Grater has a photo with a very clear number visible, this being 704.530-5. Hopefully that will clear that one up.
